## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Pesticides – Use of Chlorpyrifos – Prohibition**

3 FOR the purpose of prohibiting, on or after a certain date, the use of chlorpyrifos in the  
4 State; requiring the State Department of Agriculture to provide to farmers, certified  
5 crop advisors, and pesticide applicators certain education and assistance under  
6 certain circumstances; and generally relating to the use of chlorpyrifos.

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,  
13 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14 **Article – Agriculture**

15 **5–210.6.**

16 **ON OR AFTER JANUARY 1, 2020, A PERSON MAY NOT USE CHLORPYRIFOS IN**  
17 **THE STATE, INCLUDING:**

18 **(1) INSECTICIDES THAT CONTAIN CHLORPYRIFOS; OR**

19 **(2) SEEDS THAT HAVE BEEN TREATED WITH CHLORPYRIFOS.**

**HOUSE BILL 275**

1 Agriculture shall, with existing budgeted resources, provide to farmers, certified crop  
2 advisors, and pesticide applicators education and assistance relating to integrated pest  
3 management, including information on safer alternatives to chlorpyrifos.

4 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
5 October 1, 2019.
