1 (D) (C) THE STATE MAY WITHDRAW FROM A REGIONAL GOVERNMENTAL 2 INITIATIVE, AGREEMENT, OR COMPACT ENTERED INTO UNDER THIS SECTION IF THE 3 GENERAL ASSEMBLY ENACTS A LAW TO APPROVE THE WITHDRAWAL.
