1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Crimes – Adultery – Repeal**

3 FOR the purpose of repealing the crime of adultery; and generally relating to adultery.

9 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,

10 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

11 **Article – Criminal Law**

12 [10–501.

13 (a) A person may not commit adultery.

14 (b) A person who violates this section is guilty of a misdemeanor and on conviction

15 shall be fined \$10.]

16 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect

17 October 1, 2019.
