A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Somerset County – Alcoholic Beverages – Board of License Commissioners –**
3 **Salaries**

4 FOR the purpose of increasing the salary of the chair, members, clerk, and attorney of the
5 Board of License Commissioners for Somerset County; and generally relating to
6 alcoholic beverages in Somerset County.

17 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
18 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

19 **Article – Alcoholic Beverages**

20 29–102.

21 This title applies only in Somerset County.

22 29–204.

HOUSE BILL 290

1 (a) (1) The chair of the Board shall receive a salary of [~~\$3,500~~] **\$4,000**
2 annually.

3 (2) Each other member of the Board shall receive a salary of [~~\$3,000~~]
4 **\$3,500** annually.

5 (3) The County Commissioners shall pay the salaries of the members of the
6 Board.

7 (4) The County Commissioners may pay for expenses of the Board,
8 including:

9 (i) salaries of personnel other than members of the Board; and

10 (ii) costs of printing, supplies, and other expenses related to the
11 operation of the Board.

12 (b) The Board may:

13 (1) employ:

14 (i) a secretary;

15 (ii) inspectors; and

16 (iii) clerical and other assistants as are necessary; and

17 (2) except as otherwise provided in this section, set the compensation of the
18 employees.

19 (c) The Board:

20 (1) shall appoint a clerk to the Board at a salary of [~~\$3,500~~] **\$4,000**
21 annually; and

22 (2) may designate an attorney for the Board at a salary of [~~\$4,000~~] **\$4,500**
23 annually.

24 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July
25 1, 2019.
