AN ACT concerning
Limited Fishing Guide Lieense Natural Resources - Payment for Serviee Special Charter Boat License-Alteration

FOR the purpose of authorizing a pern in fishing guid if the person is guiding errain boats or vels that proped by ears or paddle and portsin lieense; prohibiting a ortsin person guided underacertain liense frombeing required to porertain lieense; and penerally pelating to limit fishing guide liensecifying that a certain special charter boat license issued by the Department of Natural Resources is valid for certain individuals on a single vessel operated by a certain licensed fishing guide and for certain individuals on a vessel under the guidance of a certain licensed fishing guide in tidal waters of the State; and generally relating to special charter boat licenses.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
