BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

29 (3) On or before September 1, 2016, and every 3 years thereafter, the 30 Maryland Police Training and Standards Commission shall certify to the Comptroller the 31 political subdivisions in which the crime rate exceeds the State's crime rate.
