Water Pollution Control – Public Notification of Sewer Overflows and Treatment Plant Bypasses – Alteration

4 FOR the purpose of repealing a requirement that a certain report of a sewer overflow or treatment plant bypass provided to the Department of the Environment by an owner 5 6 or operator of certain sewer systems or wastewater treatment plants be made by 7 telephone; specifying the content of the procedures that the Department of the 8 Environment, in cooperation with the Maryland Department of Health, local health 9 departments, and local environmental health directors, is required to develop for an 10 owner or operator of certain sewer systems or wastewater treatment plants to 11 provide public notification of a sewer overflow or treatment plant bypass; applying 12 the public notification requirement to treatment plant bypasses; authorizing the owner or operator of certain sewer systems or wastewater treatment plants to 13 14 provide the public notification in a certain manner under certain circumstances: 15 making a stylistic change; making a conforming change; and generally relating to 16 sewer overflows and treatment plant bypasses.
