Vehicle Laws – Licenses, Identification Cards, and Moped Operator's Permits – Indication of Applicant's Sex

- FOR the purpose of requiring that an application for a license, an identification card, or a
 moped operator's permit allow an applicant to indicate the applicant's sex in a
 certain manner; requiring the Motor Vehicle Administration to ensure that the
 license, identification card, or moped operator's permit of an applicant who indicates
 that the applicant's sex is unspecified displays a certain notation in the location that
 indicates the applicant's sex; prohibiting the Administration from requiring a certain
 applicant to provide proof of the applicant's sex; prohibiting the Administration from
- denying a certain application under certain circumstances; and generally relating to

2 (A) AN APPLICATION FOR A LICENSE, AN IDENTIFICATION CARD, OR A 3 MOPED OPERATOR'S PERMIT SHALL ALLOW AN APPLICANT TO INDICATE THAT THE 4 SEX THE APPLICANT IDENTIFIES AS IS:

5 (1) FEMALE;

6 (2) MALE; OR

7 (3) UNSPECIFIED.

8 (B) THE ADMINISTRATION SHALL ENSURE THAT THE LICENSE, 9 IDENTIFICATION CARD, OR MOPED OPERATOR'S PERMIT OF AN APPLICANT WHO HAS 10 INDICATED AN UNSPECIFIED SEX ON AN APPLICATION DISPLAYS AN "X" IN THE 11 LOCATION ON THE LICENSE, IDENTIFICATION CARD, OR MOPED OPERATOR'S 12 PERMIT THAT INDICATES THE APPLICANT'S SEX.

13 (C) THE ADMINISTRATION MAY NOT:

14(1) REQUIRE AN APPLICANT FOR A LICENSE, AN IDENTIFICATION15CARD, OR A MOPED OPERATOR'S PERMIT TO PROVIDE PROOF OF THE APPLICANT'S16SEX; OR

17 (2) DENY AN APPLICATION FOR A LICENSE, AN IDENTIFICATION 18 CARD, OR A MOPED OPERATOR'S PERMIT BECAUSE THE SEX SELECTED BY THE 19 APPLICANT DOES NOT MATCH THE SEX INDICATED ON ANOTHER DOCUMENT 20 ASSOCIATED WITH THE APPLICANT.
