## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **St. Mary's County – Charitable or Fundraising Campaign Fraud – Police**  
3 **Dispatcher**

4 FOR the purpose of altering the definition of “public safety officer” applicable to a certain  
5 prohibition against charitable or fundraising campaign fraud to include a certain  
6 police dispatcher in St. Mary's County; and generally relating to fraud.

17 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,  
18 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
