## **HOUSE BILL 569**

Except as provided in subsection [(f)] (E) of this section, if the 1 (c) (1)2 employees of a local board are covered by its county merit system: 3 the employees shall be classified employees under the county (i) merit system; and 4 the employees may be appointed and removed subject to the 5 (ii) personnel regulations of the county in which the local board is located. 6 7 (2) If the employees of a local board are not covered by its county merit 8 system: 9 (i) the employees shall be in the skilled service or professional 10 service of the State Personnel Management System; 11 (ii) appointment and removal of the employees shall be in accordance 12 with the provisions of the State Personnel and Pensions Article that govern skilled service or professional service employees; and 13 14 notwithstanding § 4-201 of the State Personnel and Pensions (iii) 15 Article, upon recommendation of the State Administrator, the State Board shall determine 16 the fixed rate of compensation of the employees. 17 (d)Each classified employee shall be a registered voter of the State.
