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## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Environment – Water Quality Certifications**  
3 **(Pipeline and Water Protection Act of 2019)**

4 FOR the purpose of requiring a person seeking to construct a natural gas pipeline to apply  
5 for a certain water quality certification and pay a certain fee; requiring the  
6 Department of the Environment to establish a certain fee for the submission and  
7 review of a water quality certification application; specifying how the Department  
8 will determine the amount of the fee; requiring that the fee be deposited, credited,  
9 and appropriated in a certain manner; requiring the Department to review a water  
10 quality certification application in accordance with certain provisions of law;  
11 prohibiting the Department from waiving certain authority to review a water quality  
12 certification application; requiring the Department to review a water quality  
13 certification application for completeness within a certain number of days; requiring  
14 the Department to provide a certain notice under certain circumstances; specifying  
15 the criteria that must be included in the Department’s review of a water quality  
16 certification application; authorizing the Department to request certain information  
17 in a certain manner during its review of a water quality certification application;  
18 authorizing the Department to deny a water quality certification application under  
19 certain circumstances; requiring the Department to take certain actions if the  
20 Department determines that a water quality certification application should be  
21 approved; requiring the Department to take a certain action on a water quality  
22 certification application within a certain period of time; requiring a person seeking  
23 to construct a natural gas pipeline to submit certain plans to the Department;  
24 prohibiting a person from beginning to construct a certain natural gas pipeline until  
25 a certain approval authority approves certain plans; requiring the approval  
26 authority to review and make a certain decision on certain plans and revisions of

1 certain plans within a certain number of days; requiring the approval authority to  
2 provide a certain rationale to a certain person in a certain manner; defining certain  
3 terms; making this Act an emergency measure; and generally relating to water  
4 quality certifications.

4 CERTIFICATION REQUESTED IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 401 OF THE FEDERAL  
5 CLEAN WATER ACT.

10 A PERSON SEEKING TO CONSTRUCT AN INTERSTATE NATURAL GAS PIPELINE  
11 SHALL:

12 (1) APPLY TO THE DEPARTMENT FOR A WATER QUALITY  
13 CERTIFICATION IN ACCORDANCE WITH COMAR 28.08.02.10; AND

14 (2) PAY A NONREFUNDABLE FEE UNDER § 14-605 OF THIS SUBTITLE.

15 14-605.

16 (A) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL ESTABLISH A NONREFUNDABLE FEE FOR THE  
17 SUBMISSION AND REVIEW OF AN APPLICATION.

18 (B) THE AMOUNT OF THE FEE SHALL BE:

19 (1) BASED ON:

20 (i) THE SIZE OF THE PROPOSED PROJECT;

21 (ii) THE ESTIMATED OR ACTUAL COSTS INCURRED BY THE  
22 DEPARTMENT FOR IMPLEMENTATION OF THIS SUBTITLE; AND

23 (iii) ANY OTHER FACTORS THE DEPARTMENT CONSIDERS  
24 NECESSARY; AND

25 (2) THE GREATER OF:

1                   **(I)     \$400; OR**

2                   **(II)    1% OF THE GROSS VALUE OF THE PROPOSED PROJECT, NOT**  
3 **TO EXCEED \$20,000.**

4           **(C)    THE FEE SHALL BE:**

5                   **(1)    DEPOSITED IN THE STATE TREASURY; AND**

6                   **(2)    CREDITED TO AN ACCOUNT OF THE DEPARTMENT.**

2 **CONSTRUCTION WILL OCCUR; AND**

3           **(4) A PERSON WHO MADE A REQUEST IN WRITING TO RECEIVE**  
4 **NOTICE.**

11 **GROUNDWATER MAPPING;**

12           **(3) POTENTIAL IMPACTS ON:**

13                   **(i) PRIVATE DRINKING WATER WELLS LOCATED WITHIN 500**  
14 **FEET OF THE CONSTRUCTION SITE;**

15                   **(ii) DOWNSTREAM WATER SUPPLIES; AND**

16                   **(iii) DRINKING WATER AQUIFERS LOCATED WITHIN 500 FEET OF**  
17 **THE CONSTRUCTION SITE;**

18           **(4) CUMULATIVE IMPACTS ON THE WATERSHED WITHIN WHICH**  
19 **CONSTRUCTION MAY OCCUR, INCLUDING IMPACTS ON WATERWAYS FROM**  
20 **INFRASTRUCTURE ASSOCIATED WITH THE CONSTRUCTION OR CONNECTION OF A**  
21 **PIPELINE;**

22           **(5) ALL ACTIVITIES THAT WILL OCCUR IN UPLAND AREAS WITHIN THE**  
23 **WATERSHED WITHIN WHICH CONSTRUCTION MAY OCCUR, INCLUDING ACTIVITIES:**

24                   **(i) ON SLOPES WITH A GRADE GREATER THAN 15%;**

25                   **(ii) IN KARST TERRAIN, INCLUDING SINKHOLES AND**  
26 **UNDERGROUND SPRINGS;**

27                   **(iii) THAT ARE DETERMINED BY THE DEPARTMENT, IN**  
28 **CONSULTATION WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES, TO BE CLOSE**

1 TO SENSITIVE STREAMS AND WETLANDS;

2 (IV) ON LAND WITH SEASONALLY HIGH WATER TABLES;

3 (V) WITHIN 500 FEET OF A WATER IMPOUNDMENT STRUCTURE  
4 OR RESERVOIR; AND

5 (VI) IN AREAS THAT HAVE:

6 1. HIGHLY ERODIBLE SOILS;

7 2. ACID SULFATE SOILS; OR

8 3. SOILS WITH A LOW PH;

9 (6) HOW THE GREENHOUSE GAS EMISSIONS ASSOCIATED WITH A  
10 PROPOSED PROJECT WILL IMPACT WATER QUALITY; AND

11 (7) HOW A PROPOSED PROJECT MAY NEED TO BE MODIFIED TO  
12 ACCOUNT FOR CLIMATE CHANGE, INCLUDING MODIFICATIONS TO THE:

13 (I) ASSOCIATED GRADING AND SEDIMENT CONTROL PLAN;

14 (II) ASSOCIATED STORMWATER MANAGEMENT PLAN; AND

15 (III) DEPTH OF THE PIPELINE.

17 (A) (1) AT ANY TIME DURING THE REVIEW OF AN APPLICATION, THE  
18 DEPARTMENT MAY MAKE A WRITTEN REQUEST TO THE APPLICANT FOR ADDITIONAL  
19 INFORMATION THE DEPARTMENT CONSIDERS NECESSARY TO CONDUCT ITS  
20 REVIEW.

21 (2) (I) SUBJECT TO SUBPARAGRAPH (II) OF THIS PARAGRAPH, THE  
22 DEPARTMENT SHALL SPECIFY IN THE REQUEST FOR INFORMATION THE DATE BY  
23 WHICH THE INFORMATION MUST BE SUBMITTED TO THE DEPARTMENT.

24 (II) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL GIVE AN APPLICANT A  
25 REASONABLE AMOUNT OF TIME TO RESPOND TO A REQUEST FOR INFORMATION  
26 MADE UNDER THIS SECTION.

27 (B) THE DEPARTMENT MAY DENY AN APPLICATION IF AN APPLICANT FAILS

1 TO PROVIDE THE INFORMATION REQUESTED BY THE DATE SPECIFIED IN THE  
2 INFORMATION REQUEST.

4 (A) IF, ON COMPLETION OF THE REVIEW REQUIRED UNDER THIS PART, THE  
5 DEPARTMENT DETERMINES THAT AN APPLICATION SHOULD BE APPROVED, THE  
6 DEPARTMENT SHALL:

7 (1) SUBJECT TO SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION, DEVELOP A  
8 DRAFT WATER QUALITY CERTIFICATION;

9 (2) MAKE THE DRAFT WATER QUALITY CERTIFICATION AVAILABLE  
10 FOR PUBLIC COMMENT;

11 (3) MAKE THE INFORMATION CONTAINED IN THE APPLICATION AND  
12 ANY ADDITIONAL INFORMATION OBTAINED THROUGH AN INFORMATION REQUEST  
13 UNDER § 14-609 OF THIS SUBTITLE AVAILABLE TO THE PUBLIC; AND

14 (4) HOLD A PUBLIC HEARING IN EACH COUNTY IN WHICH  
15 CONSTRUCTION MAY OCCUR.

16 (B) THE DRAFT WATER QUALITY CERTIFICATION REQUIRED UNDER  
17 SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION SHALL INCLUDE ANY ADDITIONAL CONDITIONS  
18 THAT THE DEPARTMENT DETERMINES ARE NECESSARY TO PROTECT WATER  
19 QUALITY.

21 (A) (1) AFTER THE PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD, THE DEPARTMENT  
22 SHALL, WITHIN 1 YEAR OF SUBMISSION OF A COMPLETE APPLICATION, ISSUE A  
23 DECISION IN ACCORDANCE WITH PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION TO  
24 APPROVE, APPROVE WITH CONDITIONS, OR DENY AN APPLICATION.

25 (2) A DECISION ISSUED UNDER PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION  
26 SHALL:

27 (I) BE IN WRITING;

28 (II) BE MADE AVAILABLE TO THE PUBLIC; AND

9           **(A) A PERSON SEEKING TO CONSTRUCT A NATURAL GAS PIPELINE SHALL**  
10 **SUBMIT TO THE DEPARTMENT:**

11           **(1) A GRADING AND SEDIMENT CONTROL PLAN FOR THE**  
12 **CONSTRUCTION OF THE PIPELINE TO THE APPROPRIATE APPROVAL AUTHORITY IN**  
13 **ACCORDANCE WITH TITLE 4, SUBTITLE 1 OF THIS ARTICLE; AND**

14           **(2) A STORMWATER MANAGEMENT PLAN FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF**  
15 **THE PIPELINE TO THE APPROPRIATE APPROVAL AUTHORITY IN ACCORDANCE WITH**  
16 **TITLE 4, SUBTITLE 2 OF THIS ARTICLE.**

17           **(B) A PERSON SEEKING TO CONSTRUCT A NATURAL GAS PIPELINE MAY NOT**  
18 **BEGIN CONSTRUCTION, INCLUDING LAND-DISTURBING ACTIVITIES, UNTIL THE**  
19 **APPROPRIATE APPROVAL AUTHORITY APPROVES A GRADING AND SEDIMENT**  
20 **CONTROL PLAN AND A STORMWATER MANAGEMENT PLAN FOR THE CONSTRUCTION**  
21 **OF THE PIPELINE.**

23           **(A) (1) AN APPROVAL AUTHORITY SHALL REVIEW AND MAKE A DECISION**  
24 **WHETHER TO APPROVE, APPROVE WITH CONDITIONS, OR DENY A GRADING AND**  
25 **SEDIMENT CONTROL PLAN OR A STORMWATER MANAGEMENT PLAN WITHIN 60 DAYS**  
26 **OF SUBMISSION OF THE PLAN.**

27           **(2) THE APPROVAL AUTHORITY SHALL PROVIDE, IN WRITING, THE**  
28 **RATIONALE FOR DENYING A GRADING AND SEDIMENT CONTROL PLAN OR A**  
29 **STORMWATER MANAGEMENT PLAN TO THE PERSON THAT SUBMITTED THE PLAN.**

30           **(B) IF A PERSON RESUBMITS A REVISED GRADING AND SEDIMENT CONTROL**



1 **PLAN OR A REVISED STORMWATER MANAGEMENT PLAN THAT WAS PREVIOUSLY**  
2 **DENIED, THE APPROVAL AUTHORITY SHALL REVIEW AND MAKE A DECISION**  
3 **WHETHER TO APPROVE THE PLAN WITHIN 30 DAYS OF RESUBMISSION.**

4 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act is an emergency  
5 measure, is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health or safety, has  
6 been passed by a ye and nay vote supported by three-fifths of all the members elected to  
7 each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, and shall take effect from the date it is  
8 enacted.
