## CHAPTER \_\_\_\_\_

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Housing – Local Housing Grant Program for Homeless Veterans and Survivors**  
3 **of Domestic Violence**

4 FOR the purpose of establishing the Local Housing Grant Program for Homeless Veterans  
5 and Survivors of Domestic Violence to provide certain grants for housing voucher  
6 funds to counties for use to house homeless veterans and survivors of domestic  
7 violence; requiring the Department of Housing and Community Development to  
8 distribute certain grants to counties under certain circumstances, establish  
9 procedures for receiving and evaluating certain grant applications, monitor the  
10 operation of the grants, and adopt certain regulations; authorizing the Governor to  
11 include ~~at least a certain amount of money~~ funding in the annual budget for the  
12 Program; specifying that the money is supplemental to and is not intended to take  
13 the place of certain funding; authorizing the Department to establish preferences  
14 under the Program for counties that take certain actions; defining a certain term;  
15 and generally relating to the Local Housing Grant Program for Homeless Veterans  
16 and Survivors of Domestic Violence.

18 Article – Housing and Community Development

19 Section 4–2501 through 4–2505 to be under the new subtitle “Subtitle 25. Local  
20 Housing Grant Program for Homeless Veterans and Survivors of Domestic  
21 Violence”

3 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,  
4 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

5 **Article – Housing and Community Development**

6 **SUBTITLE 25. LOCAL HOUSING GRANT PROGRAM FOR HOMELESS VETERANS AND**  
7 **SURVIVORS OF DOMESTIC VIOLENCE.**

8 **4-2501.**

9 IN THIS SUBTITLE, “PROGRAM” MEANS THE LOCAL HOUSING GRANT  
10 PROGRAM FOR HOMELESS VETERANS AND SURVIVORS OF DOMESTIC VIOLENCE.

11 **4-2502.**

12 (A) THERE IS A LOCAL HOUSING GRANT PROGRAM FOR HOMELESS  
13 VETERANS AND SURVIVORS OF DOMESTIC VIOLENCE.

14 (B) THE PURPOSE OF THE PROGRAM IS TO PROVIDE GRANTS FOR HOUSING  
15 VOUCHER FUNDS TO COUNTIES FOR USE TO HOUSE HOMELESS VETERANS AND  
16 SURVIVORS OF DOMESTIC VIOLENCE.

17 **4-2503.**

18 **THE DEPARTMENT SHALL:**

19 (1) DISTRIBUTE GRANTS TO COUNTIES THAT MAY APPLY UNDER THE  
20 PROGRAM FOR RAPID OR PERMANENT HOUSING VOUCHER FUNDS FOR HOMELESS  
21 VETERANS AND SURVIVORS OF DOMESTIC VIOLENCE;

22 (2) ESTABLISH PROCEDURES FOR RECEIVING AND EVALUATING  
23 GRANT APPLICATIONS FROM COUNTIES UNDER THE PROGRAM;

24 (3) MONITOR THE OPERATION OF THE GRANTS; AND

25 (4) ADOPT REGULATIONS TO CARRY OUT THIS SUBTITLE.

26 **4-2504.**

27 (A) FOR FISCAL YEAR 2020 AND EACH FISCAL YEAR THEREAFTER, THE  
28 GOVERNOR MAY INCLUDE ~~AT LEAST \$2,000,000~~ FUNDING IN THE ANNUAL BUDGET  
29 FOR THE PROGRAM.

1 (B) MONEY EXPENDED FROM THE PROGRAM IS SUPPLEMENTAL TO AND IS  
2 NOT INTENDED TO TAKE THE PLACE OF FUNDING THAT OTHERWISE WOULD BE  
3 APPROPRIATED BY THE DEPARTMENT TO ADDRESS HOMELESSNESS.

4 4-2505.

5 THE DEPARTMENT MAY ESTABLISH PREFERENCES UNDER THE PROGRAM  
6 FOR COUNTIES THAT:

7 (1) ENACT AN ORDINANCE THAT PROHIBITS DISCRIMINATION IN  
8 HOUSING ON THE BASIS OF SOURCE OF INCOME;

9 (2) ADOPT A HOUSING FIRST POLICY, AS DEFINED BY THE  
10 DEPARTMENT; OR

11 (3) PROVIDE AN ADDITIONAL 25% COUNTY DEDICATED FUNDING OR  
12 VOUCHER MATCH.

13 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
14 October 1, 2019.
