 Under General Supervision of Licensed Dentist

4 FOR the purpose of altering a certain provision of law to provide that a general license to 5 practice dental hygiene authorizes the licensee to practice dental hygiene under the 6 general supervision of a licensed dentist in certain facilities, rather than only in a 7 long-term care facility; altering the requirements, including the time period of active 8 clinical experience, that a dental hygienist is required to meet before being 9 authorized to practice dental hygiene under the general supervision of a licensed 10 dentist in certain facilities; altering the requirements that must be met by a dental hygienist who is practicing under the general supervision of a licensed dentist in 11 12 certain facilities and performing a certain dental hygiene service; making 13 conforming changes; defining a certain term certain terms; repealing a certain definition; and generally relating to the authority of dental hygienists to practice 14 15 under the general supervision of licensed dentists.
