A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

Harford County Parishioner Protection Pilot Program

FOR the purpose of authorizing, in Harford County, a person to, without a permit, carry a 3 4 handgun on the property of a church or religious organization during certain events $\mathbf{5}$ and transport a handgun to and from certain church or religious organization events 6 if the person has the consent of a certain church or religious organization to carry a 7 handgun on the property of the church or religious organization during certain 8 events and has the intent to wear, carry, or transport a handgun for certain purposes 9 on the property of the church or religious organization; requiring the Harford County Sheriff to submit a certain report to the Governor and the General Assembly on or 10 11 before a certain date; providing for the termination of this Act; and generally relating 12to permits to carry, wear, or transport a handgun.

18 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
19 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 21 5-303.

(A) [A] EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION, A person
shall have a permit issued under this subtitle before the person carries, wears, or transports
a handgun.

(B) (1) THIS SUBSECTION APPLIES ONLY IN HARFORD COUNTY.

2 (2) A PERSON WHO HAS THE WRITTEN CONSENT OF THE GOVERNING 3 BOARD OF A BONA FIDE CHURCH OR RELIGIOUS ORGANIZATION TO CARRY A 4 HANDGUN ON THE PROPERTY OF THE CHURCH OR RELIGIOUS ORGANIZATION 5 DURING SERVICES AND GATHERINGS AND HAS THE INTENT TO WEAR, CARRY, OR 6 TRANSPORT A HANDGUN FOR PURPOSES RELATED TO SELF–PROTECTION OR THE 7 PROTECTION OF OTHERS WHILE ON THE PROPERTY OF THE CHURCH OR RELIGIOUS 8 ORGANIZATION MAY, WITHOUT A PERMIT:

9 (I) CARRY A HANDGUN ON THE PROPERTY OF THE CHURCH OR 10 RELIGIOUS ORGANIZATION DURING SERVICES AND GATHERINGS; AND

11(II) TRANSPORT A HANDGUN TO AND FROM SERVICES AND12GATHERINGS OF THE CHURCH OR RELIGIOUS ORGANIZATION.

13 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, on or before December 31, 14 2020, the Harford County Sheriff shall report to the Governor and, in accordance with § 15 2–1246 of the State Government Article, the General Assembly on the effect on Harford 16 County of § 5–303(b) of the Public Safety Article, as enacted by Section 1 of this Act, 17 including:

(1) the number of persons who have obtained written consent to carry a
handgun on the property of a church or religious organization in Harford County under this
Act;

21 (2) the number of times that handguns have been carried without a permit 22 on the property of a church or religious organization in Harford County under this Act;

23 (3) the effect on public safety in Harford County of this Act; and

(4) any problems that have been experienced in Harford County as a resultof this Act.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2019. It shall remain effective for a period of 2 years and, at the end of June 30, 2021, this Act, with no further action required by the General Assembly, shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.
