2 **Harford County – Alcoholic Beverages – Annual Financial Audit**

3 FOR the purpose of requiring the Board of License Commissioners for Harford County to
4 submit a financial audit to certain individuals at a certain time each year for review;
5 specifying that the financial audit is not subject to approval by certain individuals;
6 and generally relating to alcoholic beverages in Harford County.

17 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
18 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

3 (A) AT THE END OF EACH FISCAL YEAR, THE BOARD SHALL SUBMIT A
4 FINANCIAL AUDIT FOR REVIEW TO:

5 (1) THE COUNTY EXECUTIVE; AND

6 (2) THE HARFORD COUNTY DELEGATION TO THE MARYLAND
7 GENERAL ASSEMBLY, CONSISTING OF HARFORD COUNTY SENATORS AND
8 DELEGATES.

9 (B) THE FINANCIAL AUDIT IS NOT SUBJECT TO APPROVAL BY THE COUNTY
10 EXECUTIVE OR THE HARFORD COUNTY DELEGATION TO THE MARYLAND GENERAL
11 ASSEMBLY, CONSISTING OF HARFORD COUNTY SENATORS AND DELEGATES.

12 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July
13 1, 2019.
