### A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

## 2 Motor Vehicles – Motorcycles – Overtaking and Passing Vehicles

3 FOR the purpose of requiring the Motor Vehicle Administration to adopt certain guidelines 4 for the operation of a motorcycle on a roadway that is divided into two or more clearly  $\mathbf{5}$ marked lanes for vehicular traffic; repealing certain provisions of law that prohibit 6 an operator of a motorcycle on certain roadways from overtaking and passing in the 7 same lane occupied by the vehicle being overtaken and from operating a motorcycle 8 between lanes of traffic or between adjacent lanes or rows of vehicles; making a 9 certain conforming change; and generally relating to the operation of motorcycles on roadways. 10

- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,

5 (e)] Motorcycles may not be operated more than two abreast in a single lane.

6 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 7 October 1, 2019.
