SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, 11 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

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Article – Tax – General

11 - 235.14

IN THIS SECTION, "FIREARM SAFETY DEVICE" MEANS A FIREARM SAFE, 15(A) FIREARM LOCKBOX, TRIGGER AND BARREL LOCK, OR ANY OTHER ITEM DESIGNED 16 17 TO ENHANCE HOME FIREARM SAFETY.

18 **(B)** THE SALES AND USE TAX DOES NOT APPLY TO THE SALE OF A FIREARM 19 SAFETY DEVICE.

20SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 211, 2019.
