A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Education – Juvenile Services Education Programs – Management and**
3 **Operation**

4 FOR the purpose of altering the categories of individuals who are authorized to be employed
5 or contracted to provide education services for a certain time period with a certain
6 salary; extending the date for the State Department of Education to convene a
7 workgroup to analyze the results of the Juvenile Services Education County Pilot
8 Program; extending the deadline for the workgroup to report its findings and
9 recommendations; extending the termination date for the workgroup; and generally
10 relating to juvenile services education programs.

19 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
20 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

21 **Article – Education**

22 6–302.

23 (a) Except as provided in subsection (c) of this section, an individual who is
24 employed as a teacher, librarian, principal, director of education, or supervisor of vocational
25 education on the staffs of the following institutions or in the following programs, or an

1 individual who is employed as a central office director, superintendent, specialist, or
2 coordinator of education for the following institutions or programs, shall be paid the annual
3 salary determined under subsection (b) of this section:

4 (1) Any institution that is under the jurisdiction of:

5 (i) The Department of Juvenile Services;

6 (ii) The Maryland Department of Health; or

7 (iii) The Juvenile Services Education [County Pilot] Program in the
8 Department;

9 (2) Any vocational rehabilitation program operated by the State
10 Department of Education; and

11 (3) Any correctional education program operated by the Department of
12 Labor, Licensing, and Regulation in a facility of the Department of Public Safety and
13 Correctional Services.

14 (c) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, an individual in a position
15 described under subsection (a) of this section at an institution that is under the jurisdiction
16 of the Juvenile Services Education [County Pilot] Program in the Department may be
17 employed or contracted to provide education services for a 10-month or 2-month period
18 with a salary commensurate with the period of employment.

20 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That:

21 (a) On or before January 1, [2019] **2020**, the State Department of Education shall
22 convene a workgroup to analyze the results of the pilot program established under §
23 22-308 of the Education Article.

24 (g) On or before December 1, [2019] **2020**, the workgroup shall report its findings
25 and recommendations to the Governor and, in accordance with § 2-1246 of the State
26 Government Article, the General Assembly.

27 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July
28 1, 2018. Section 2 of this Act shall remain effective for a period of [2 years] **3 YEARS** and,
29 at the end of June 30, [2020] **2021**, Section 2 of this Act, with no further action required
30 by the General Assembly, shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.

31 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July
32 1, 2019.
