## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **State Athletic Commission – Sunset Extension**

3 FOR the purpose of continuing the State Athletic Commission in accordance with the  
4 provisions of the Maryland Program Evaluation Act (sunset law) by extending to a  
5 certain date the termination provisions relating to the statutory and regulatory  
6 authority of the Commission; requiring that an evaluation of the Commission and  
7 the statutes and regulations that relate to the Commission be performed on or before  
8 a certain date; and generally relating to the State Athletic Commission.

24 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,  
25 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

2 Subject to the evaluation and reestablishment provisions of the Maryland Program  
3 Evaluation Act, this subtitle and Subtitle 3 of this title and all regulations adopted under  
4 this subtitle and Subtitle 3 of this title shall terminate on July 1, [2021] **2031**.

5 **Article – State Government**

6 8–403.

7 (a) On or before December 15 of the evaluation year specified, the Department  
8 shall:

9 (1) conduct a preliminary evaluation of each governmental activity or unit  
10 to be evaluated under this section; and

11 (2) prepare a report on each preliminary evaluation conducted.

12 (b) Each of the following governmental activities or units and the statutes and  
13 regulations that relate to the governmental activities or units are subject to preliminary  
14 evaluation in the evaluation year specified:

15 (5) Athletic Commission, State (§ 4–201 of the Business Regulation Article:  
16 [2018] **2028**);

17 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
18 October 1, 2019.
