Washington County - Archery Hunting - Safety Zone

- 3 FOR the purpose of altering the size of the safety zone for archery hunters in Washington 4 County within which archery hunting may not take place except under certain 5 circumstances; requiring that an archery hunter in Washington County be in a 6 certain position when hunting any wild bird or mammal within a certain distance of 7 certain buildings; and generally relating to the archery hunting safety zone in 8 Washington County.

- 14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
- 15 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Natural Resources 16

- 17 10-410.
- 18 Except as provided in paragraphs (2) and (3) of this subsection, a 19 person, other than the owner or occupant, while hunting for any wild bird or mammal may 20 not shoot or discharge any firearm or other deadly weapon within 150 yards, known as the "safety zone", of a dwelling house, residence, church, or other building or camp occupied by 2122human beings, or shoot at any wild bird or mammal while it is within this area, without
- 23the specific advance permission of the owner or occupant.
- 24**(2)** A person, while hunting for any wild bird or mammal, may not shoot or 25 discharge any firearm within 300 yards of a public or nonpublic school during school hours



1 or at a time when a school–approved activity is taking place.

- 2 (3) (i) For archery hunters in Calvert County, Carroll County, 3 Frederick County, Harford County, Montgomery County, [or] St. Mary's County, OR
- 4 WASHINGTON COUNTY, the safety zone described in paragraph (1) of this subsection
- 5 extends for 50 yards from a dwelling house, residence, church, or any other building or
- 6 camp occupied by human beings.
- 7 (ii) For archery hunters in Anne Arundel County, the safety zone 8 described in paragraph (1) of this subsection extends for 100 yards from a dwelling house, 9 residence, church, or any other building or camp occupied by human beings.
- 10 (4) During any open hunting season, a person, other than the owner or occupant, may not hunt or chase willfully any wild bird or mammal within the safety zone without the specific advance permission of the owner or occupant.
- 13 (5) In Harford County, an archery hunter shall use a tree stand when 14 hunting any wild bird or mammal within 50 to 100 yards of a dwelling house, residence, 15 church, public or nonpublic school, or other building or camp occupied by human beings.
- 16 (6) In Montgomery County **OR WASHINGTON COUNTY**, an archery 17 hunter shall be in an elevated position that allows the hunter to shoot in a downward 18 trajectory when hunting any wild bird or mammal within 50 to 100 yards of a dwelling 19 house, residence, church, public or nonpublic school, or other building or camp occupied by 20 human beings.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2019.
