- 2 (A) There is a Class C (volunteer fire department) beer, wine, and 3 liquor license.
- 4 (B) THE BOARD MAY ISSUE THE LICENSE FOR USE BY A VOLUNTEER FIRE 5 DEPARTMENT.
- 6 (C) THE LICENSE AUTHORIZES THE LICENSE HOLDER TO SELL BEER, WINE, 7 AND LIQUOR AT RETAIL AT THE PLACE DESCRIBED IN THE LICENSE FOR 8 ON-PREMISES CONSUMPTION.
- 9 (D) THE LICENSE HOLDER MAY SELL BEER, WINE, AND LIQUOR DURING THE 10 HOURS AND DAYS AS SET OUT FOR A CLASS C BEER, WINE, AND LIQUOR LICENSE 11 UNDER § 26–2004 OF THIS TITLE.
- 12 **(E)** THE ANNUAL LICENSE FEE IS \$910.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2019.
