## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **High Schools – Postsecondary Career and Technology Education Programs –**  
3 **Reporting on Student Acceptance Rates**

4 FOR the purpose of requiring each local school system to report to the State Department of  
5 Education on or before a certain date each year certain information regarding high  
6 school students accepted into certain postsecondary career and technology education  
7 programs during a certain time period; requiring the Department to publish on its  
8 website on or before a certain date each year certain information regarding high  
9 school students accepted into certain postsecondary career and technology education  
10 programs during a certain time period; and generally relating to reporting on  
11 postsecondary career and technology education programs acceptance rates of high  
12 school students.

18 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,  
19 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

20 **Article – Education**

21 **7–211.**

22 **(A) ON OR BEFORE MARCH 1 EACH YEAR, EACH LOCAL SCHOOL SYSTEM**  
23 **SHALL REPORT TO THE DEPARTMENT:**

24 **(1) THE NUMBER OF STUDENTS FROM EACH HIGH SCHOOL WHO WERE**

2 PROGRAMS DURING THE PREVIOUS CALENDAR YEAR; AND

3 (2) THE TYPES OF PROGRAMS IN WHICH THE STUDENTS WERE  
4 ACCEPTED.

5 (B) (1) ON OR BEFORE APRIL 1 EACH YEAR, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL  
6 PUBLISH ON ITS WEBSITE A LIST OF THE HIGH SCHOOLS THAT REPORTED ON  
7 STUDENTS WHO WERE ACCEPTED INTO POSTSECONDARY CAREER AND  
8 TECHNOLOGY EDUCATION PROGRAMS DURING THE PREVIOUS CALENDAR YEAR.

9 (2) THE LIST SHALL INCLUDE:

10 (I) THE NUMBER OF STUDENTS ACCEPTED PER HIGH SCHOOL;  
11 AND

12 (II) THE TYPES OF PROGRAMS IN WHICH THE STUDENTS WERE  
13 ACCEPTED.

14 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July  
15 1, 2019.
