16 17 18	(A) IN THIS SECTION, "MOBILITYLINK" MEANS A SPECIALIZED TRANSIT SERVICE AVAILABLE TO INDIVIDUALS WHO, BECAUSE OF A DISABILITY, ARE FUNCTIONALLY UNABLE TO:
19	(1) GET TO A BUS STOP;
20	(2) WAIT UNASSISTED AT A BUS STOP OR TRAIN STATION; OR
21	(3) BOARD OR RIDE A BUS OR TRAIN WITHOUT ASSISTANCE.
