A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Baltimore County – Maryland Stadium Authority – Public School Construction**

3 FOR the purpose of requiring the Maryland Stadium Authority to perform certain actions;
4 authorizing the Authority to issue bonds to finance the construction of or
5 improvements to certain Baltimore County public school facilities subject to certain
6 limitations; specifying that the Authority and the Baltimore County Board of
7 Education shall be responsible for certain public school facilities construction and
8 improvement projects subject to a certain memorandum of understanding;
9 prohibiting the interference with or limitation of the powers of the Authority and the
10 Baltimore County Board except under certain circumstances; specifying that certain
11 expenses incurred by the Authority are payable only from certain funds; requiring
12 the Authority to provide certain written notice within a certain time frame;
13 specifying that certain bonds are a limited obligation of the Authority payable solely
14 from certain pledged money and are not a debt, a liability, a moral obligation, or a
15 pledge of the faith and credit or taxing power of the State, the Authority, or any other
16 governmental unit; requiring the Authority to obtain approval from the Board of
17 Public Works before each issuance of bonds to finance improvements to Baltimore
18 County public school facilities; prohibiting the total debt service from exceeding a
19 certain amount; requiring Baltimore County to deposit a certain amount of money
20 into a certain fund; requiring the Authority to transfer certain funds under certain
21 circumstances; authorizing the Authority to transfer certain funds under certain
22 circumstances; requiring the Authority to direct the State Comptroller to withhold
23 certain income tax revenues from Baltimore County and instead deposit that money
24 into a certain fund under a certain circumstance; requiring a certain joint report on
25 or before a certain date each year; providing for certain requirements for the
26 Baltimore County Board regarding certain buildable sites and certain operational
27 responsibilities; providing for the payment of certain costs; requiring the Authority,
28 Baltimore County, the Baltimore County Board, and the Interagency Commission on
29 School Construction to agree to a certain memorandum of understanding on or before
30 a certain date; prohibiting the issuance of bonds to finance improvements to
31 Baltimore County public school facilities unless the memorandum of understanding

1 is signed by certain parties; specifying the requirements of the memorandum of
2 understanding; requiring the State Superintendent of Schools to facilitate resolution
3 in the event of a dispute of certain provisions in the memorandum of understanding;
4 prohibiting the memorandum of understanding from taking effect until it is approved
5 by the Board of Public Works; establishing the Baltimore County Public School
6 Construction Financing Fund and the Baltimore County Public School Construction
7 Facilities Fund as continuing, nonlapsing funds; specifying the contents of the funds
8 and providing for the uses of the funds; exempting the funds from a certain provision
9 of law requiring interest on State money in special funds to accrue to the General
10 Fund of the State; limiting the amount of debt that may be issued by the Authority
11 to finance certain public school construction projects in Baltimore County including
12 nontax-supported debt; providing that money deposited in a certain fund may be
13 used as security for a bond issue; altering the distribution of certain State lottery
14 revenues and requiring the State Comptroller to distribute certain State lottery
15 revenues into a certain fund; requiring certain reports and notifications; defining
16 certain terms; providing for a delayed effective date for certain provisions of this Act;
17 and generally relating to public school construction.

7 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
8 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

9 **Article – Economic Development**

10 10–601.

11 (a) In this subtitle the following words have the meanings indicated.

12 (b) “Authority” means the Maryland Stadium Authority.

13 (c) “Authority affiliate” means a for–profit or nonprofit entity in which the
14 Authority directly or indirectly owns any membership interest or equity interest.

15 (d) “Baltimore City” means, as the context requires:

16 (1) the geographic area of the City of Baltimore; or

17 (2) the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore.

18 (e) “Baltimore City Board of School Commissioners” means the Baltimore City
19 Board of School Commissioners of the Baltimore City Public School System established
20 under § 3–108.1 of the Education Article.

21 (f) “Baltimore City Public School Construction Facilities Fund” means the
22 Baltimore City Public School Construction Facilities Fund established under § 10–657 of
23 this subtitle.

24 (g) “Baltimore City Public School Construction Financing Fund” means the
25 Baltimore City Public School Construction Financing Fund established under § 10–656 of
26 this subtitle.

27 (h) “Baltimore City public school facility” means a property primarily used for
28 educational instruction that:

29 (1) is held in trust by Baltimore City or the Baltimore City Board of School
30 Commissioners for the benefit of the Baltimore City Public School System; and

31 (2) is designated for improvement under the memorandum of

1 understanding between the Authority, Baltimore City, the Baltimore City Board of School
2 Commissioners, and the Interagency Commission on School Construction entered into in
3 accordance with § 10–646 of this subtitle.

4 (i) “Baltimore City public school site” means the site of any Baltimore City public
5 school facility.

6 (j) (1) “Baltimore Convention facility” means:

7 (i) a convention center, trade show facility, meeting hall, or other
8 structure in Baltimore City used to hold conventions, trade shows, meetings, displays, or
9 similar events; and

10 (ii) offices, parking lots or garages, access roads, hotels, restaurants,
11 railroad sidings, and any other structures, improvements, equipment, furnishings, or other
12 property functionally related to the facilities described in item (i) of this paragraph.

13 (2) “Baltimore Convention facility” includes the following, if used, useful,
14 or usable in the future as, or in connection with, a Baltimore Convention facility:

15 (i) land, structures, equipment, property, property rights, property
16 appurtenances, rights-of-way, franchises, easements, and other interests in land;

17 (ii) land and facilities that are functionally related to a Baltimore
18 Convention facility; and

19 (iii) patents, licenses, and other rights necessary or useful to
20 construct or operate a Baltimore Convention facility.

21 (k) “Baltimore Convention Fund” means the Baltimore Convention Financing
22 Fund established under § 10–651 of this subtitle.

23 (l) “Baltimore Convention site” means the site of the Baltimore Convention
24 Center located in Baltimore City at the address generally known as 1 West Pratt Street,
25 identified in the State Department of Assessments and Taxation Real Property database
26 as tax identification number Ward 22, Section 01, Block 0682, Lots 001 and 001A.

27 **(M) “BALTIMORE COUNTY” MEANS, AS THE CONTEXT REQUIRES:**

28 **(1) THE GEOGRAPHIC AREA OF BALTIMORE COUNTY; OR**

29 **(2) THE COUNTY EXECUTIVE AND COUNTY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE**
30 **COUNTY.**

31 **(N) “BALTIMORE COUNTY BOARD” MEANS THE BALTIMORE COUNTY**
32 **BOARD OF EDUCATION ESTABLISHED UNDER TITLE 3 OF THE EDUCATION ARTICLE.**

1 **(O) “BALTIMORE COUNTY PUBLIC SCHOOL CONSTRUCTION FACILITIES**
2 **FUND” MEANS THE BALTIMORE COUNTY PUBLIC SCHOOL CONSTRUCTION**
3 **FACILITIES FUND ESTABLISHED UNDER § 10–659 OF THIS SUBTITLE.**

4 **(P) “BALTIMORE COUNTY PUBLIC SCHOOL CONSTRUCTION FINANCING**
5 **FUND” MEANS THE BALTIMORE COUNTY PUBLIC SCHOOL CONSTRUCTION**
6 **FINANCING FUND ESTABLISHED UNDER § 10–658 OF THIS SUBTITLE.**

7 **(Q) “BALTIMORE COUNTY PUBLIC SCHOOL FACILITY” MEANS A PROPERTY**
8 **PRIMARILY USED FOR EDUCATION INSTRUCTION THAT:**

9 **(1) IS HELD IN A TRUST BY BALTIMORE COUNTY OR THE BALTIMORE**
10 **COUNTY BOARD FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE BALTIMORE COUNTY PUBLIC SCHOOL**
11 **SYSTEM; AND**

12 **(2) IS DESIGNATED FOR IMPROVEMENT UNDER THE MEMORANDUM**
13 **OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN THE AUTHORITY, BALTIMORE COUNTY, THE**
14 **BALTIMORE COUNTY BOARD, AND THE INTERAGENCY COMMISSION ON SCHOOL**
15 **CONSTRUCTION ENTERED INTO IN ACCORDANCE WITH § 10–650 OF THIS SUBTITLE.**

16 **(R) “BALTIMORE COUNTY PUBLIC SCHOOL SITE” MEANS THE SITE OF ANY**
17 **BALTIMORE COUNTY PUBLIC SCHOOL FACILITY.**

18 **[(m)] (S)** “Bond” includes a note, an interim certificate, refunding bond, and any
19 other evidence of obligation issued under this subtitle.

20 **[(n)] (T)** “Camden Yards” means the area comprising approximately 85 acres in
21 Baltimore City bounded by Camden Street on the north, Russell Street on the west, Ostend
22 Street on the south, and Howard Street and Interstate 395 on the east.

23 **[(o)] (U)** “Camden Yards Fund” means the Camden Yards Financing Fund
24 established under § 10–652 of this subtitle.

25 **[(p)] (V)** “Convention facility” means the Baltimore Convention facility, the
26 Montgomery County Conference facility, and the Ocean City Convention facility.

27 **[(q)] (W)** “Facility” means:

28 (1) a structure or other improvement developed at Camden Yards;

29 (2) a convention facility;

30 (3) the Hippodrome Performing Arts facility;

1 (4) a sports facility; [or]

2 (5) a Baltimore City public school facility; **OR**

3 **(6) A BALTIMORE COUNTY PUBLIC SCHOOL FACILITY.**

4 **[(r)] (X)** “Governmental unit” means a county, a municipal corporation, a unit
5 of State or local government, or any other public body created under State or local law.

6 **[(s)] (Y)** (1) “Hippodrome Performing Arts facility” means the performing
7 arts center facility located at the Hippodrome Performing Arts site.

8 (2) “Hippodrome Performing Arts facility” includes, at the Hippodrome
9 Performing Arts site:

10 (i) the Hippodrome theater and offices;

11 (ii) food service facilities; and

12 (iii) any other functionally related property, structures,
13 improvements, furnishings, or equipment.

14 **[(t)] (Z)** “Hippodrome Performing Arts Fund” means the Hippodrome
15 Performing Arts Financing Fund established under § 10–653 of this subtitle.

16 **[(u)] (AA)** “Hippodrome Performing Arts site” means the site of the
17 France–Merrick Performing Arts Center located in Baltimore City at the address generally
18 known as:

19 (1) 12 North Eutaw Street Building, identified in the State Department of
20 Assessments and Taxation Real Property database as tax identification number Ward 04,
21 Section 08, Block 0631, Lot 001; and

22 (2) 401 West Fayette Street, identified in the State Department of
23 Assessments and Taxation Real Property database as tax identification number Ward 04,
24 Section 08, Block 0631, Lot 013.

25 **[(v)] (BB)** “Improve” means to add, alter, construct, equip, expand, extend,
26 improve, install, reconstruct, rehabilitate, remodel, or repair.

27 **[(w)] (CC)** “Improvement” means addition, alteration, construction, equipping,
28 expansion, extension, improvement, installation, reconstruction, rehabilitation,
29 remodeling, or repair.

30 **[(x)] (DD)** “Montgomery County” includes the Montgomery County Revenue
31 Authority.

1 **[(y)] (EE)** (1) “Montgomery County Conference facility” means the Conference
2 Center facility located at the Montgomery County Conference site used for conferences,
3 trade shows, meetings, displays, or similar events.

4 (2) “Montgomery County Conference facility” includes, at the Montgomery
5 County Conference site, offices, parking lots and garages, access roads, food service
6 facilities, and other functionally related property, structures, improvements, furnishings,
7 or equipment.

8 (3) “Montgomery County Conference facility” does not include the privately
9 owned hotel adjacent to the Montgomery County Conference Center.

10 **[(z)] (FF)** “Montgomery County Conference Fund” means the Montgomery
11 County Conference Financing Fund established under § 10–654 of this subtitle.

12 **[(aa)] (GG)** “Montgomery County Conference site” means the site of the
13 Montgomery County Conference Center located in Rockville at the address generally
14 known as 5701 Marinelli Road, identified in the State Department of Assessments and
15 Taxation Real Property database as tax identification number District 04, Account Number
16 03392987.

17 **[(bb)] (HH)** (1) “Ocean City Convention facility” means:

18 (i) a convention center, trade show facility, meeting hall, or other
19 structure in Ocean City used to hold conventions, trade shows, meetings, displays, or
20 similar events; and

21 (ii) offices, parking lots or garages, access roads, food service
22 facilities, and any other structures, improvements, equipment, furnishings, or other
23 property functionally related to the facilities described in item (i) of this paragraph.

24 (2) “Ocean City Convention facility” includes the following, if used, useful,
25 or usable in the future as, or in connection with, an Ocean City Convention facility:

26 (i) land, structures, equipment, property, property rights, property
27 appurtenances, rights-of-way, franchises, easements, and other interests in land;

28 (ii) land and facilities that are functionally related to an Ocean City
29 Convention facility; and

30 (iii) patents, licenses, and other rights necessary or useful to
31 construct or operate an Ocean City Convention facility.

32 **[(cc)] (II)** “Ocean City Convention Fund” means the Ocean City Convention
33 Financing Fund established under § 10–655 of this subtitle.

2 Convention Center located in Ocean City at the address generally known as 4001 Coastal
3 Highway, identified in the State Department of Assessments and Taxation Real Property
4 database as tax identification numbers District 10, Account Number 055237; District 10,
5 Account Number 066301; District 10, Account Number 247942; and District 10, Account
6 Number 280346.

7 ~~[(ee)]~~ **(KK)** (1) “Sports facility” means:

8 (i) a stadium primarily for professional football, major league
9 professional baseball, or both, in the Baltimore metropolitan region, as defined in § 13–301
10 of this article;

11 (ii) practice fields or other areas where professional football or major
12 league professional baseball teams practice or perform; and

13 (iii) offices for professional football and major league professional
14 baseball teams or franchises.

15 (2) “Sports facility” includes parking lots, garages, and any other property
16 adjacent and directly related to an item listed in paragraph (1) of this subsection.

17 ~~[(ff)]~~ **(LL)** “Tax supported debt” has the meaning stated in § 8–104 of the State
18 Finance and Procurement Article.

20 (e) (1) This subsection does not apply to the Camden Yards site, Baltimore
21 Convention site, Ocean City Convention site, Hippodrome Performing Arts site, or any
22 Baltimore City **OR BALTIMORE COUNTY** public school site.

23 (2) The Authority and any Authority affiliate is subject to applicable
24 planning, zoning, and development regulations to the same extent as a private commercial
25 or industrial enterprise.

26 (f) The Authority shall:

27 (1) in cooperation with Baltimore City, appoint a task force that includes
28 residents and business and institutional representatives from the area adjacent to Camden
29 Yards to review the schematic, preliminary, and final plans for facilities at Camden Yards;

30 (2) submit schematic plans for development of Camden Yards and the
31 Baltimore Convention site to Baltimore City for review and comment before acquiring any
32 property;

33 (3) with respect to Camden Yards, the Baltimore Convention facility, and

1 the Hippodrome Performing Arts facility, submit preliminary and final plans to Baltimore
2 City for review and comment;

3 (4) with respect to Camden Yards, the Baltimore Convention facility, and
4 the Hippodrome Performing Arts facility, participate in the design review processes of
5 Baltimore City; [and]

6 (5) with respect to a Baltimore City public school facility, perform the
7 actions required under §§ 10–645, 10–646, 10–656, and 10–657 of this subtitle; **AND**

8 **(6) WITH RESPECT TO A BALTIMORE COUNTY PUBLIC SCHOOL**
9 **FACILITY, PERFORM THE ACTIONS REQUIRED UNDER §§ 10–649, 10–650, 10–658,**
10 **AND 10–659 OF THIS SUBTITLE.**

12 (c) (1) Unless authorized by the General Assembly, the Board of Public Works
13 may not approve an issuance by the Authority of bonds, whether taxable or tax exempt,
14 that constitute tax supported debt or nontax supported debt if, after issuance, there would
15 be outstanding and unpaid more than the following face amounts of the bonds for the
16 purpose of financing acquisition, construction, renovation, and related expenses for
17 construction management, professional fees, and contingencies in connection with:

18 (i) the Baltimore Convention facility – \$55,000,000;

19 (ii) the Hippodrome Performing Arts facility – \$20,250,000;

20 (iii) the Montgomery County Conference facility – \$23,185,000;

21 (iv) the Ocean City Convention facility – \$17,340,000; [and]

22 (v) Baltimore City public school facilities – \$1,100,000,000; **AND**

23 **(VI) BALTIMORE COUNTY PUBLIC SCHOOL FACILITIES –**
24 **\$750,000,000.**

25 (2) (i) The limitation under paragraph (1)(i) of this subsection applies
26 to the aggregate principal amount of bonds outstanding as of June 30 of any year.

27 (ii) Refunded bonds may not be included in the determination of an
28 outstanding aggregate amount under this paragraph.

30 (a) A pledge by the Authority of revenues or money deposited in the Baltimore
31 City Public School Construction Financing Fund **OR THE BALTIMORE COUNTY PUBLIC**

1 **SCHOOL CONSTRUCTION FINANCING FUND** as security for an issue of bonds is valid
2 and binding from when the pledge is made.

3 (b) (1) The revenues or money deposited in the Baltimore City Public School
4 Construction Financing Fund **OR IN THE BALTIMORE COUNTY PUBLIC SCHOOL**
5 **CONSTRUCTION FINANCING FUND** that are pledged are immediately subject to the lien
6 of the pledge without any physical delivery or further act.

7 (2) The lien of any pledge is valid and binding against any person having a
8 claim against the Authority in tort, contract, or otherwise, regardless of whether the person
9 has notice of the lien.

10 (c) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, in order to perfect a lien on
11 pledged revenues or money deposited in the Baltimore City Public School Construction
12 Financing Fund **OR THE BALTIMORE COUNTY PUBLIC SCHOOL CONSTRUCTION**
13 **FINANCING FUND** against a third person, it is not necessary to file or record any document
14 adopted or entered into by the Authority in any public record other than in the records of
15 the Authority.

18 **UNDERSTANDING UNDER § 10-650 OF THIS SUBTITLE, THE AUTHORITY SHALL**

20 **IMPROVEMENTS TO A BALTIMORE COUNTY PUBLIC SCHOOL FACILITY.**

21 (2) **THE AUTHORITY AND THE BALTIMORE COUNTY BOARD, AS**
22 **AGREED TO IN THE MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING UNDER § 10-650 OF THIS**
23 **SUBTITLE AND SUBJECT TO PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION, SHALL BE**
24 **RESPONSIBLE FOR SCHOOL FACILITIES CONSTRUCTION AND IMPROVEMENTS**
25 **FINANCED WITH THE PROCEEDS OF BONDS ISSUED UNDER THIS SUBTITLE IN**
26 **ACCORDANCE WITH THE BALTIMORE COUNTY PUBLIC SCHOOLS' EDUCATIONAL**
27 **FACILITIES MASTER PLAN, WHICH MAY BE AMENDED FROM TIME TO TIME IN**
28 **ACCORDANCE WITH PARAMETERS ESTABLISHED FOR REVIEW AND COMMENT IN THE**
29 **MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING ESTABLISHED UNDER § 10-650 OF THIS**
30 **SUBTITLE.**

31 (3) (I) **EXCEPT AS AGREED TO IN THE MEMORANDUM OF**
32 **UNDERSTANDING UNDER § 10-650 OF THIS SUBTITLE AND SUBJECT TO**
33 **SUBPARAGRAPH (II) OF THIS PARAGRAPH, A POWER GRANTED TO THE AUTHORITY**
34 **UNDER THIS SUBTITLE MAY NOT IN ANY WAY INTERFERE WITH THE ENUMERATED**
35 **POWERS OF THE BALTIMORE COUNTY BOARD UNDER TITLE 3 OF THE EDUCATION**
36 **ARTICLE.**

1 **(II) THE POWERS OF THE BALTIMORE COUNTY BOARD MAY NOT**
2 **LIMIT THE ABILITY OF THE AUTHORITY TO CARRY OUT ITS OBLIGATIONS UNDER**
3 **THIS SUBTITLE WITH RESPECT TO IMPROVEMENT OF BALTIMORE COUNTY PUBLIC**
4 **SCHOOL FACILITIES AND THE FINANCING RELATED TO THE IMPROVEMENTS.**

5 **(B) (1) THE AUTHORITY MAY NOT USE ANY CURRENT SOURCES OF**
6 **FUNDS, WHETHER APPROPRIATED OR NONBUDGETED, TO PAY FOR ANY COSTS OR**
7 **EXPENSES RELATED TO FINANCING IMPROVEMENTS TO BALTIMORE COUNTY**
8 **PUBLIC SCHOOL FACILITIES.**

9 **(2) THE SOLE SOURCE OF PAYMENT FOR ANY COSTS OR EXPENSES**
10 **RELATED TO FINANCING IMPROVEMENTS TO BALTIMORE COUNTY PUBLIC SCHOOL**
11 **FACILITIES SHALL BE THE MONEY ON DEPOSIT IN THE BALTIMORE COUNTY PUBLIC**
12 **SCHOOL CONSTRUCTION FACILITIES FUND AND THE BALTIMORE COUNTY PUBLIC**
13 **SCHOOL CONSTRUCTION FINANCING FUND AND BOND PROCEEDS HELD UNDER A**
14 **TRUST AGREEMENT.**

15 **(C) AT LEAST 45 DAYS BEFORE SEEKING APPROVAL OF THE BOARD OF**
16 **PUBLIC WORKS FOR EACH BALTIMORE COUNTY PUBLIC SCHOOL FACILITIES BOND**
17 **ISSUE, THE AUTHORITY SHALL PROVIDE TO THE FISCAL COMMITTEES OF THE**
18 **GENERAL ASSEMBLY WRITTEN NOTICE OF:**

19 **(1) THE AGGREGATE AMOUNT OF FUNDS NEEDED FOR THE RELEVANT**
20 **BALTIMORE COUNTY PUBLIC SCHOOL FACILITIES TO BE FINANCED WITH THE**
21 **PROPOSED BONDS, INCLUDING A LIST OF THE FACILITIES TO BE IMPROVED;**

22 **(2) THE ANTICIPATED TOTAL DEBT SERVICE FOR THE PROPOSED**
23 **BOND ISSUE; AND**

24 **(3) THE ANTICIPATED TOTAL DEBT SERVICE WHEN COMBINED WITH**
