3 **Employees and Management Personnel**

4 FOR the purpose of altering the definitions of “supervisory employee” and “management
5 personnel” by removing a provision that status as a supervisory employee and
6 management personnel may be determined by certain negotiations between a certain
7 public school employer and a certain employee organization; and generally relating
8 to collective bargaining for noncertificated employees.

19 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
20 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

2 (a) In this subtitle the following words have the meanings indicated.

3 (e) "Management personnel" includes an individual who is engaged mainly in
4 executive and managerial functions[, as determined by the public school employer in
5 negotiation with an employee organization that requests negotiation on this issue].

6 (i) "Supervisory employee" includes any individual who responsibly directs the
7 work of other employees[, as determined by the public school employer in negotiation with
8 an employee organization that requests negotiation on this issue].

9 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July
10 1, 2019.
