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Higher Education – Cyber Warrior Diversity Program – Revisions

3 FOR the purpose of altering the locations of the Cyber Warrior Diversity Program in the 4 State: requiring certain governing entities to use a certain curriculum and to award certain contracts or memoranda of understanding to certain businesses; requiring $\mathbf{5}$ 6 the Governor to include certain appropriations in the annual State operating budget 7 to provide grants to certain entities and to hold a certain conference; specifying the 8 amounts and uses of certain grants provided under the Program; altering the date 9 by which certain governing entities must notify the Maryland Higher Education 10 Commission regarding certain enrollment; requiring the Commission to allocate 11 certain funds to certain entities on a certain basis; requiring a certain entity to hold a certain conference annually on or before a certain date; defining certain terms; 12altering a certain definition; and generally relating to the Cyber Warrior Diversity 13 14 Program.
