# SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

#### Article – Education

16 (a) In this section, "Fund" means the Small Business Development Center 17 Network Fund.

18 (b) There is a Small Business Development Center Network Fund.

19 (c) The purpose of the Fund is to provide matching funds for federal grant funds 20 and to support the operations of the Small Business Development Center Network in the 21 University of Maryland, College Park Campus.

(d) The Fund is a special, continuous, nonlapsing fund that is not subject to §
 7-302 of the State Finance and Procurement Article.
