A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

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Task Force to Study the Local Economic Impact of Bank Deserts in Maryland

- 3 FOR the purpose of establishing the Task Force to Study the Local Economic Impact of Bank Deserts in Maryland; providing for the composition, chair, and staffing of the 4 5 Task Force; prohibiting a member of the Task Force from receiving certain 6 compensation, but authorizing the reimbursement of certain expenses; requiring the 7 Task Force to study and make recommendations regarding certain matters relating 8 to the local economic impact of opening new credit unions or banks in bank deserts 9 in the State; requiring the Task Force to report its findings and recommendations to the General Assembly on or before a certain date; providing for the termination of 10 11 this Act; and generally relating to the Task Force to Study the Local Economic 12 Impact of Bank Deserts in Maryland.
- 13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, 14 That:
- 15 (a) There is a Task Force to Study the Local Economic Impact of Bank Deserts in 16 Maryland.
- 17 (b) The Task Force consists of the following members:
- 18 (1) two members of the Senate of Maryland, appointed by the President of 19 the Senate:
- 20 (2) two members of the House of Delegates, appointed by the Speaker of 21 the House;
- 22 (3) the Commissioner of Financial Regulation, or the Commissioner's 23 designee;
- 24 (4) the Secretary of Commerce, or the Secretary's designee;

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- 2 (g) On or before January 1, 2020, the Task Force shall report its findings and 3 recommendations, in accordance with $\S 2-1246$ of the State Government Article, to the 4 General Assembly.
 - SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2019. It shall remain effective for a period of 2 years and, at the end of June 30, 2021, this Act, with no further action required by the General Assembly, shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.
