BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, 15That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: Chapter 779 of the Acts of 2018 16 17SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, 18 That: 19 There is a Prince George's County Environmental Justice Commission. 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1 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June 2 1, 2018. It shall remain effective for a period of [1 year] **2 YEARS** and 1 month and, at the 3 end of June 30, [2019] **2020**, this Act, with no further action required by the General 4 Assembly, shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.

5 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June 6 1, 2019.
