- 17 EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED IN THIS TITLE, AN INSURER SHALL
- 18 MAINTAIN RECORDS OF INSURANCE TRANSACTIONS RELATED TO EACH INDIVIDUAL
- 19 OR GROUP POLICY OF LIFE INSURANCE AND EACH INDIVIDUAL OR GROUP ANNUITY
- 20 FOR A PERIOD OF AT LEAST 7 YEARS AFTER THE POLICY OR ANNUITY IS NO LONGER
- IN EFFECT. 21
- 22 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect

1 October 1, 2019.
