A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Horse Racing at Fair Hill – Union Hospital Allocation – Repeal**

3 FOR the purpose of repealing a requirement that a certain licensee allocate the profits
4 earned from horse racing at a certain location to a certain hospital; and generally
5 relating to horse racing at Fair Hill.

6 BY repealing

11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,

12 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

13 **Article – Business Regulation**

14 11–702.

15 [(e) The licensee shall allocate to the Union Hospital of Cecil County all profits
16 earned under this subtitle, including money from pari-mutuel betting, admission charges,
17 and other receipts.]

18 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
19 October 1, 2019.
