10 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
11 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

13 **7–311.**

14 **THE LONG-TAILED SALAMANDER (EURYCEA LONGICAUDA) IS THE STATE**
15 **AMPHIBIAN.**

16 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
17 October 1, 2019.
