4 FOR the purpose of authorizing, for purposes of filing a certain petition for certain 5 immigration status, a certain victim or victim's family member to request a certain 6 certifying official to certify victim helpfulness on a Form I-918, Supplement B 7 certification under certain circumstances; providing that, for the purposes of this Act, 8 a victim shall be considered to be helpful, to have been helpful, or likely to be helpful 9 under certain circumstances; requiring the certifying official to sign and complete 10 the certification in a certain manner and within a certain period of time under 11 certain circumstances; providing that certain conditions are not required to request 12 or obtain the certification; authorizing the certifying official to withdraw the 13 certification only under certain circumstances; authorizing a certifying entity to disclose the immigration status of a victim or person requesting the certification only 14 15 under certain circumstances; defining certain terms; and generally relating to 16 certain certifications of victim helpfulness for U Nonimmigrant Status certification.
