- FOR the purpose of establishing a certain minimum amount for a certain annual appropriation in the State budget for the Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Annapolis to pay for services provided to the State by the City of Annapolis; requiring that each fiscal year the annual appropriation be increased by a certain amount; repealing an obsolete provision; and generally relating to a mandated appropriation

- 14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
- 15 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

16 Article – State Finance and Procurement

- 18 (A) Annually, the State shall appropriate IN THE STATE BUDGET and pay to the
- 19 Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Annapolis [the sum provided in the State budget] AT
- 20 **LEAST \$750,000** as payment for [:
- 21 (1) the collection of refuse from State buildings located in the City of
- 22 Annapolis; and
- 23 (2) other services provided to the State by the City of Annapolis.



- 1 (B) FOR FISCAL YEAR 2022 AND EACH FISCAL YEAR THEREAFTER, THE
 2 APPROPRIATION REQUIRED UNDER SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION SHALL BE
 3 INCREASED BY THE PERCENT INCREASE IN THE CONSUMER PRICE INDEX FOR ALL
 4 URBAN CONSUMERS FOR THE BALTIMORE METROPOLITAN STATISTICAL AREA.
- 5 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 6 1, 2019.
