A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

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Human Services – Food Supplements (Summer SNAP for Children Act)

- 4 FOR the purpose of requiring the State to provide a certain supplement for certain $\mathbf{5}$ individuals in a household that receives certain federally funded benefits; providing 6 for the amount of the supplemental benefit; providing that the supplemental benefit 7 is subject to certain requirements; providing that the supplemental benefit is for 8 each child in the household; requiring the supplemental benefit to be provided in 9 certain months; establishing the manner in which the supplemental benefit is 10 provided; prohibiting a household from receiving more than one supplemental 11 benefit per child; requiring a county to submit a certain application by a certain date 12to receive funding for the supplemental benefit; requiring the application to include 13 certain information; requiring the Department of Human Services to notify certain 14 counties of certain available funding on or before a certain date each year; providing 15that receipt of certain funding by a county is contingent on approval of a certain final 16plan; requiring certain counties to submit a certain final plan to the Department on 17or before a certain date; requiring the Department to approve or reject a certain final plan and provide notice of the decision on or before a certain date; allowing a county 18 19with a rejected final plan to submit a revised final plan for approval; requiring the 20Department to certify available funding for an approved final plan; specifying the 21manner in which available funding for the supplemental benefit is apportioned 22among counties with approved final plans; requiring the Governor to appropriate 23certain amounts of funding for the supplemental benefits in certain fiscal years; 24authorizing a county to provide certain additional funding; prohibiting certain 25required funding from being affected by certain additional funding; defining a certain 26term; and generally relating to the food stamp program.

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1 (II) RECEIPT OF AVAILABLE FUNDING UNDER SUBPARAGRAPH 2 (I) OF THIS PARAGRAPH IS CONTINGENT ON APPROVAL BY THE DEPARTMENT OF A 3 COUNTY'S FINAL PLAN SUBMITTED IN ACCORDANCE WITH PARAGRAPH (3) OF THIS 4 SUBSECTION.

5 (3) ON OR BEFORE MARCH 1 EACH YEAR, A COUNTY THAT IS 6 NOTIFIED OF AVAILABLE FUNDING SHALL SUBMIT A FINAL PLAN TO THE 7 DEPARTMENT THAT INCLUDES:

8 (I) A MARKETING AND COMMUNICATION PLAN TO INFORM 9 ELIGIBLE FAMILIES OF THE FOOD STAMP PROGRAM AND THE SUPPLEMENTS 10 AVAILABLE UNDER THIS SECTION;

(II) IF FUNDING IS NOT SUFFICIENT TO PROVIDE A MINIMUM
SUPPLEMENT OF \$100 TO ALL CHILDREN IN THE COUNTY RECEIVING FOOD STAMP
PROGRAM BENEFITS IN THE FISCAL YEAR, A DESIGNATION OF WHICH CHILDREN
WILL BE ELIGIBLE TO RECEIVE THE SUPPLEMENTS UNDER THIS SECTION;

15(III) THE CRITERIA USED TO DETERMINE ELIGIBILITY UNDER16ITEM (II) OF THIS PARAGRAPH; AND

22 (4) (I) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL REVIEW A FINAL PLAN 23 SUBMITTED UNDER PARAGRAPH (3) OF THIS SUBSECTION AND APPROVE OR REJECT 24 THE FINAL PLAN.

25 (II) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL NOTIFY A COUNTY OF ITS 26 DECISION UNDER SUBPARAGRAPH (I) OF THIS PARAGRAPH ON OR BEFORE MAY 15.

(III) IF THE DEPARTMENT REJECTS A COUNTY'S FINAL PLAN,
 THE COUNTY MAY SUBMIT A REVISED FINAL PLAN FOR APPROVAL.

29 (IV) IF THE DEPARTMENT APPROVES A COUNTY'S FINAL PLAN, 30 THE DEPARTMENT SHALL CERTIFY THE AMOUNT OF FUNDING THAT WILL BE

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1 PROVIDED TO THE COUNTY IN THE FOLLOWING FISCAL YEAR.

2 (5) EACH COUNTY WITH AN APPROVED FINAL PLAN SHALL BE 3 AWARDED FUNDING IN ACCORDANCE WITH SUBSECTION (F) OF THIS SECTION.

4 (F) (1) (I) THE GOVERNOR SHALL INCLUDE \$2,000,000 IN THE FISCAL 5 2021 BUDGET FOR THE SUPPLEMENTS UNDER SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION.

6 (II) IN FISCAL YEAR 2022 AND EACH FISCAL YEAR THEREAFTER, 7 THE GOVERNOR SHALL INCLUDE AN ADDITIONAL \$500,000 OVER THE PRIOR FISCAL 8 YEAR APPROPRIATION FOR THE SUPPLEMENTS UNDER SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS 9 SECTION.

10 (2) IN EACH FISCAL YEAR. THE DEPARTMENT SHALL PROVIDE FUNDS 11 TO EACH COUNTY WITH AN APPROVED FINAL PLAN FOR THE FISCAL YEAR IN AN 12AMOUNT EQUAL TO THE TOTAL AMOUNT OF FUNDS APPROPRIATED UNDER 13PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION MULTIPLIED BY THE NUMBER OF FOOD STAMP PROGRAM RECIPIENTS IN THE COUNTY WHO ARE ELIGIBLE FOR A BENEFIT UNDER 14THIS SECTION AND THEN DIVIDED BY THE TOTAL NUMBER OF FOOD STAMP 15PROGRAM RECIPIENTS IN THE STATE WHO ARE ELIGIBLE FOR A BENEFIT UNDER 16 17THIS SECTION.

18 (3) (I) A COUNTY MAY PROVIDE FUNDING IN ADDITION TO THE 19 FUNDING PROVIDED UNDER PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION TO INCREASE 20 THE NUMBER OF SUPPLEMENTS PROVIDED IN THE COUNTY.

(II) FUNDING PROVIDED BY A COUNTY UNDER SUBPARAGRAPH
(I) OF THIS PARAGRAPH MAY NOT AFFECT THE AMOUNT OF FUNDING THE
DEPARTMENT IS REQUIRED TO PROVIDE UNDER PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS
SUBSECTION.

25 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 26 October 1, 2019.
