2 **Election Law – Canvassing of Absentee Ballots – Reporting Unofficial Results**

3 FOR the purpose of requiring local boards of elections to prepare and release a report of
4 the unofficial results of the absentee ballot vote tabulation at the end of each day of
5 absentee ballot canvassing; and generally relating to absentee ballot vote
6 canvassing.

17 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
18 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

19 **Article – Election Law**

20 11–302.

1 (a) Following an election, each local board shall meet at its designated counting
2 center to canvass the absentee ballots cast in that election in accordance with the
3 regulations and guidelines established by the State Board.

4 (E) AT THE END OF EACH DAY OF CANVASSING, A LOCAL BOARD SHALL
5 PREPARE AND RELEASE A REPORT OF THE UNOFFICIAL RESULTS OF THE ABSENTEE
6 BALLOT VOTE TABULATION.

7 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
8 October 1, 2019.
