## CHAPTER \_\_\_\_\_

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Carroll County – Alcoholic Beverages – Class D Beer and Wine Licenses**

3 FOR the purpose of limiting the sale of beer and wine by certain license holders for  
4 off-premises consumption to the discretion of the Board of License Commissioners  
5 for Carroll County; and generally relating to alcoholic beverages in Carroll County.

16 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,  
17 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

18 **Article – Alcoholic Beverages**

19 16–102.

1 This title applies only in Carroll County.

2 16-805.

3 (a) There is a Class D beer and wine license.

4 (b) The license authorizes the license holder to sell beer and wine, at retail, at the  
5 place described in the license[.]:

6 (1) for [on- and off-premises] ON-PREMISES consumption; AND

7 (2) FOR OFF-PREMISES CONSUMPTION AT THE DISCRETION OF THE  
8 BOARD.

9 (c) The license may not be issued for use by a drugstore.

10 (d) The annual license fee is \$250.

11 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July  
12 1, 2019.
