BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments, Article – Correctional Services Section 3–215(f) Annotated Code of Maryland (2017 Replacement Volume and 2018 Supplement) SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: Article - Correctional Services 3-215.The Secretary shall require an individual to pass a polygraph (f) (1) examination OR EXTENSIVE BACKGROUND CHECK, OR BOTH, before being appointed to serve as a correctional officer in a correctional facility.
