## CHAPTER \_\_\_\_\_

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Somerset County – Alcoholic Beverages – Board of License Commissioners –**  
3 **Salaries**

4 FOR the purpose of increasing the salary of the chair, members, clerk, and attorney of the  
5 Board of License Commissioners for Somerset County; and generally relating to  
6 alcoholic beverages in Somerset County.

7 BY repealing and reenacting, without amendments,  
8 Article – Alcoholic Beverages

17 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,  
18 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

19 **Article – Alcoholic Beverages**

3 (a) (1) The chair of the Board shall receive a salary of [~~\$3,500~~] **\$4,000**  
4 annually.

5 (2) Each other member of the Board shall receive a salary of [~~\$3,000~~]  
6 **\$3,500** annually.

7 (3) The County Commissioners shall pay the salaries of the members of the  
8 Board.

9 (4) The County Commissioners may pay for expenses of the Board,  
10 including:

11 (i) salaries of personnel other than members of the Board; and

12 (ii) costs of printing, supplies, and other expenses related to the  
13 operation of the Board.

14 (b) The Board may:

15 (1) employ:

16 (i) a secretary;

17 (ii) inspectors; and

18 (iii) clerical and other assistants as are necessary; and

19 (2) except as otherwise provided in this section, set the compensation of the  
20 employees.

21 (c) The Board:

22 (1) shall appoint a clerk to the Board at a salary of [~~\$3,500~~] **\$4,000**  
23 annually; and

24 (2) may designate an attorney for the Board at a salary of [~~\$4,000~~] **\$4,500**  
25 annually.

26 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July  
27 1, 2019.
