- 3 FOR the purpose of authorizing in Baltimore County the holder of a manufacturer's license or a wholesaler's license to sell or deliver alcoholic beverages to a holder of a retail 4 $\mathbf{5}$ alcoholic beverages license on Sunday; authorizing holders of certain classes of retail 6 alcoholic beverages licenses to sell alcoholic beverages on Sunday during the same 7 hours as on the other days of the week; making certain conforming changes; and 8 generally relating to the sale of alcoholic beverages on Sunday in Baltimore County.
