CHAPTER _____

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Natural Resources – Sunday Hunting – ~~Deer~~ St. Mary's County**

3 FOR the purpose of authorizing the Department of Natural Resources to allow a person to
4 hunt ~~deer on a Sunday throughout the deer hunting season on public land designated~~
5 ~~by the Department or private property, subject to certain requirements and~~
6 ~~limitations~~, game birds or mammals on a Sunday during the open season for that
7 game bird or mammal on private property or certain public land in St. Mary's County
8 under certain circumstances; and generally relating to Sunday ~~deer~~ hunting in St.
9 Mary's County.

15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
16 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

17 **Article – Natural Resources**

18 10–410.

1 (a) (1) Except as otherwise provided in this subsection, a person may not hunt
2 any game bird or mammal on Sundays.

3 (2) The following persons may hunt the specified game birds and mammals
4 on Sundays:

5 (i) A person using State certified raptors to hunt game birds or
6 mammals during open season;

7 (ii) An unarmed person participating in an organized fox chase to
8 chase foxes;

9 (iii) Provided that the provisions of § 10–906(b)(3) of this title are
10 met, a person:

11 1. Using a regulated shooting ground under § 10–906 of this
12 title to hunt the following pen-reared game birds:

13 A. Pheasants;

14 B. Bobwhite quail;

15 C. Chukar partridge;

16 D. Hungarian partridge;

17 E. Tower released flighted mallard ducks; and

18 F. Turkey on a regulated shooting ground that was permitted
19 to release turkey before September 1, 1992; and

20 2. Having the written permission of the owner of the land or
21 other person designated by the owner of the land, if the land is owned or leased by a person
22 other than the person hunting on Sundays;

23 (iv) Subject to the provisions of § 10–411 of this subtitle, in Calvert,
24 Caroline, Carroll, Charles, Dorchester, Harford, Queen Anne's, ~~St. Mary's~~, Somerset,
25 Talbot, Wicomico, and Worcester counties, a person hunting deer on private property with
26 a bow and arrow or crossbow during open season on the last three Sundays in October and
27 the second Sunday in November;

28 (v) In Calvert County, Caroline County, Carroll County, Charles
29 County, Dorchester County, AND Kent County, ~~and St. Mary's County~~, a person hunting
30 turkey on private property on any Sunday during the spring turkey hunting season;

1 (vi) In Dorchester County, a person hunting turkey on public land
2 that is designated for hunting by the Department on any Sunday during the spring turkey
3 hunting season; and

4 (vii) A person hunting deer under a Deer Management Permit on any
5 Sunday throughout the year, including all deer hunting seasons.

6 (3) Subject to the provisions of § 10–415 of this subtitle, in Calvert County,
7 Caroline County, Charles County, Harford County, Queen Anne’s County, ~~St. Mary’s~~
8 ~~County~~, Somerset County, and Worcester County, a person may hunt deer on private
9 property on:

10 (i) The first Sunday of the bow hunting season in November; and

11 (ii) Each Sunday in the deer firearms season.

12 (4) Provided that the provisions of § 10–415 of this subtitle are met and
13 subject to paragraph (5) of this subsection, the Department may allow a person to hunt deer
14 on private property on the first Sunday of:

15 (i) The bow hunting season in November; and

16 (ii) The deer firearms season.

17 (5) Subject to paragraphs (10) and (11) of this subsection, the Sunday deer
18 hunting provisions under paragraph (4) of this subsection do not apply:

19 (i) In Baltimore, Howard, Kent, Montgomery, and Prince George’s
20 counties; and

21 (ii) In Baltimore City.

22 (6) (i) This paragraph applies only in Carroll County.

23 (ii) Subject to §§ 10–411 and 10–415 of this subtitle, the Department
24 may allow a person to hunt deer on a Sunday on private property from the first Sunday in
25 October through the second Sunday in January of the following year, inclusive.

26 (7) A person who is 16 years of age or younger may hunt deer with a firearm
27 on a Sunday through participation in the junior deer hunt established under § 10–405(a) of
28 this subtitle.

29 (8) (i) This paragraph applies only in Allegany County, Garrett County,
30 **ST. MARY’S COUNTY**, and Washington County.

1 (ii) The Department may allow a person to hunt any game bird or
2 game mammal, except migratory game birds and wetland game birds, on a Sunday during
3 the open season for that game bird or game mammal on:

- 4 1. Private property, subject to § 10–411 of this subtitle; and
- 5 2. Public land that is designated for Sunday hunting by the

6 Department.

7 (9) (i) This paragraph applies only in Frederick County.

8 (ii) Subject to § 10–415 of this subtitle, the Department may allow a
9 person to hunt deer on a Sunday from the first Sunday in October through the second
10 Sunday in January of the following year, inclusive, on:

- 11 1. Private property, subject to § 10–411 of this subtitle; and
- 12 2. Public land that is designated for Sunday hunting by the

13 Department.

14 (10) (i) This paragraph applies only in Kent County.

15 (ii) Subject to §§ 10–411 and 10–415 of this subtitle and
16 subparagraph (iii) of this paragraph, the Department may allow a person to hunt deer on
17 a Sunday on private property throughout all deer hunting seasons.

18 (iii) 1. Except as provided in subparagraph 2 of this
19 subparagraph, during firearms season, the Department may allow a person to hunt deer
20 on a Sunday only from 30 minutes before sunrise until 10:30 a.m.

21 2. The time restrictions under this subparagraph do not
22 apply:

23 A. To a participant in the junior deer hunt under § 10–405(a)
24 of this subtitle; and

25 B. On private land only on one Sunday designated by the
26 Department during the firearms season.

27 (11) (i) This paragraph applies only in Montgomery County.

28 (ii) Subject to § 10–415 of this subtitle, the Department may allow a
29 person to hunt deer on a Sunday throughout the deer hunting season on private property,
30 subject to § 10–411 of this subtitle.

1 (iii) 1. Except as provided in subparagraph 2 of this
2 subparagraph, the Department may allow a person to hunt deer on a Sunday under this
3 paragraph only from 30 minutes before sunrise until 10:30 a.m.

4 2. The time restrictions under this subparagraph do not
5 apply:

6 A. To a participant in the junior deer hunt under § 10-405(a)
7 of this subtitle;

8 B. On private land only on one Sunday designated by the
9 Department during deer bow hunting season; and

10 C. On private land only on one Sunday designated by the
11 Department during the firearms season.

12 ~~(12) SUBJECT TO THE REQUIREMENTS AND LIMITATIONS OTHERWISE~~
13 ~~PROVIDED IN THIS SUBSECTION, THE DEPARTMENT MAY ALLOW A PERSON TO HUNT~~
14 ~~DEER ON A SUNDAY THROUGHOUT THE DEER HUNTING SEASON ON PUBLIC LAND~~
15 ~~DESIGNATED BY THE DEPARTMENT OR PRIVATE PROPERTY.~~

16 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July
17 1, 2019.
