



- [(b)] (C) Unless administration of a medically important antimicrobial drug is consistent with subsection [(a)(1)] (B)(1) of this section, a medically important antimicrobial drug may not be administered in a regular pattern to cattle, swine, or poultry.
- 4 **[(c)] (D)** A medically important antimicrobial drug may not be administered to cattle, swine, or poultry solely for the purpose of:
- 6 (1) Promoting weight gain; or
- 7 (2) Improving feed efficiency.
- 8 (E) (1) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN PARAGRAPHS (2) AND (3) OF THIS 9 SUBSECTION, A MEDICALLY IMPORTANT ANTIMICROBIAL DRUG MAY NOT BE 10 ADMINISTERED TO CATTLE, SWINE, OR POULTRY FOR A PERIOD LONGER THAN 21 DAYS.

- 30 (a) Each year the Department shall collect publicly available data on the use in 31 the State of medically important antimicrobial drugs in cattle, swine, and poultry from:
- 32 (1) The U.S. Department of Agriculture;
 - (2) The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention;

- 1 (3) The U.S. Food and Drug Administration; and
- 2 (4) Appropriate national AND STATE trade associations, organizations,
- 3 and councils.
- 4 (b) ON OR BEFORE FEBRUARY 1, 2021, AND EACH FEBRUARY 1
- 5 THEREAFTER, AN OWNER A LICENSED VETERINARIAN SHALL SUBMIT TO THE
- 6 DEPARTMENT, IN A MANNER DETERMINED BY THE DEPARTMENT:
- 7 (1) A COPY OF <u>THE RECORD PRESCRIBING</u> THE MEDICALLY
- 8 IMPORTANT ANTIMICROBIAL DRUG PRESCRIPTION OR A COPY OF THE VETERINARY
- 9 FEED DIRECTIVE FOR EACH MEDICALLY IMPORTANT ANTIMICROBIAL DRUG, AS
- 10 LISTED IN APPENDIX A OF THE FEDERAL FOOD AND DRUG ADMINISTRATION'S
- 11 GUIDANCE FOR INDUSTRY #152, ADMINISTERED IN FEED OR WATER TO CATTLE,
- 12 SWINE, OR POULTRY DURING THE PREVIOUS CALENDAR YEAR; AND
- 13 (2) AN ACCOUNTING, AS PROVIDED BY THE OWNER, OF THE TOTAL
- 14 NUMBER OF ANIMALS RAISED DURING THE PREVIOUS CALENDAR YEAR,
- 15 CATEGORIZED BY SPECIES AND PRODUCTION CLASS.

- 30 (IV) INDICATIONS FOR WHICH VETERINARIANS PRESCRIBED
- 31 MEDICALLY IMPORTANT ANTIMICROBIAL DRUGS; AND

- 1 (V) PATTERNS OF USE FOR MEDICALLY IMPORTANT 2 ANTIMICROBIAL DRUGS, INCLUDING DURATION AND SEASONAL VARIATION.

- 23 (a) On or before November 1, 2019, the Department of Agriculture shall provide 24 written notice of the requirements of this Act to each owner that may be affected by this 25 Act.
- 26 (b) The notice shall be sent by first-class mail to the owner's last known address.
- SECTION 3. 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2019.
