Behavioral Health Services Matching Grant Program for Service Members and Veterans – Establishment

4 FOR the purpose of establishing the Behavioral Health Services Matching Grant Program $\mathbf{5}$ for Service Members and Veterans; providing for the purpose of the Program; 6 requiring the Maryland Department of Health to administer the Program; requiring 7 the Program to award certain grants to nonprofit organizations to establish and 8 expand certain community behavioral health programs; establishing a certain 9 eligibility requirement; requiring an eligible nonprofit organization to secure certain contributions for the proposal at least equal in value to the amount requested from 1011 the Program; requiring the Department to develop selection criteria for evaluating 12applicant proposals; requiring that the selection criteria contain positive scoring for 13 certain proposals; requiring the Department, in awarding matching grants, to give 14priority to proposals that best meet the selection criteria, regardless of cost; requiring 15the Department to establish certain application procedures; requiring the 16Department to establish a certain system of outcome measurement; requiring 17recipients of a grant under the Program to submit certain information to the 18 Department; requiring the Department to establish certain guidelines for nonprofit 19organizations receiving a grant under the Program to bill certain insurers; requiring 20the Department to establish certain procedures; authorizing, beginning in a certain 21 fiscal year, and each fiscal year thereafter, the Governor to include in the budget bill 22a certain appropriation for the Program; requiring, on or before a certain date each 23year, the Department to report certain information to the Governor and the General 24Assembly; defining certain terms; and generally relating to the Behavioral Health 25Services Matching Grant Program for Service Members and Veterans.
