7 (2) 3% OF TOTAL FUNDS EXPENDED FOR THE OPERATING BUDGET 8 FOR THE CATEGORIES IDENTIFIED IN § 5–101(B)(2) OF THIS TITLE.

9 (C) THE AMOUNT APPROPRIATED UNDER SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION 10 SHALL BE IN ADDITION TO ANY OTHER STATE FUNDS PROVIDED TO THE COUNTY 11 BOARD IN THAT FISCAL YEAR.

12 (D) EACH COUNTY BOARD THAT RECEIVES FUNDING UNDER THIS SECTION 13 MAY USE THE FUNDS ONLY TO SUPPORT THE MAINTENANCE OF SCHOOL BUILDINGS 14 AND EQUIPMENT.
