A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Washington County – Code of Public Local Laws – Legalization**

3 FOR the purpose of legalizing the 2019 edition of the Code of Public Local Laws of
4 Washington County, being Article 22 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland,
5 published under the direction of the Board of County Commissioners of Washington
6 County; making provisions for the publication, sale, and distribution of the Code of
7 Public Local Laws of Washington County; and generally relating to the legalization
8 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Washington County.

9 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
10 That the 2019 edition of the Code of Public Local Laws of Washington County, being Article
11 22 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, published under the direction of the Board
12 of County Commissioners of Washington County is legalized. Any supplement to the 2019
13 Code of Public Local Laws of Washington County that may be published under the direction
14 of the Board of County Commissioners of Washington County, is legalized. The Code shall
15 contain all the public local laws relating to Washington County following the 2019 regular
16 session of the General Assembly of Maryland. The Code shall be deemed and taken in all
17 the courts of the State and by all public officials of the State and of its several political
18 subdivisions to be evidence of the public local laws of Washington County in existence at
19 the time of the compilation.

20 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Board of County
21 Commissioners of Washington County may make an appropriation to provide for the
22 publication of this Code and the Board may provide for its sale and distribution.

23 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July
24 1, 2019.
