BY adding to Article - Education Section 7-117 Annotated Code of Maryland (2018 Replacement Volume and 2018 Supplement) Preamble WHEREAS, Green schools support the State's efforts to curb climate change and meet the State's environmental education goals established under COMAR 13A.04.17; now, therefore.
