Motor Vehicles – Temporary In–Transit Registration

3 FOR the purpose of authorizing the Motor Vehicle Administration to issue a temporary 4 in-transit registration that allows a nonresident owner of a vehicle to operate the vehicle on a highway in the State only for the purpose of transporting the vehicle to $\mathbf{5}$ a jurisdiction outside the State for titling and registration; establishing that an 6 7 application for a temporary in-transit registration may be made only by a 8 nonresident vehicle owner and only on a certain form; authorizing the 9 Administration to determine the period for which a temporary in-transit registration is valid; requiring the Administration to determine the fee to apply for 10 a temporary in-transit registration; establishing that only the Administration or 11 12licensed title service agents may issue temporary in-transit registrations; 13 establishing that a temporary in-transit registration may be issued only after the 14vehicle owner has furnished to the Administration or title service agent proof of 15identity, vehicle ownership, and insurance; prohibiting the Administration or a title

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14 (A) ON APPLICATION AND PAYMENT OF THE REQUIRED FEE, THE 15 ADMINISTRATION MAY ISSUE A TEMPORARY IN-TRANSIT REGISTRATION TO ALLOW 16 A NONRESIDENT OWNER OF A VEHICLE TO OPERATE THE VEHICLE ON A HIGHWAY IN 17 THE STATE ONLY FOR THE PURPOSE OF TRANSPORTING THE VEHICLE TO A 18 JURISDICTION OUTSIDE THE STATE IN WHICH THE VEHICLE IS TO BE TITLED AND 19 REGISTERED.

20 **(B)** AN APPLICATION FOR A TEMPORARY IN–TRANSIT REGISTRATION MAY 21 BE MADE ONLY:

- 22 (1) BY A NONRESIDENT OWNER OF A VEHICLE; AND
- 23 (2) ON THE FORM THE ADMINISTRATION REQUIRES.

24 (C) A TEMPORARY IN-TRANSIT REGISTRATION MAY BE ISSUED FOR A 25 PERIOD DETERMINED BY THE ADMINISTRATION.

26 (D) THE FEE FOR A TEMPORARY IN–TRANSIT REGISTRATION SHALL BE 27 ESTABLISHED BY THE ADMINISTRATION.

28 (E) (1) ONLY <u>THE ADMINISTRATION OR</u> A LICENSED TITLE SERVICE 29 AGENT MAY ISSUE A TEMPORARY IN–TRANSIT REGISTRATION.

30(2)A TEMPORARY IN-TRANSIT REGISTRATION MAY BE ISSUED ONLY31AFTER THE VEHICLE OWNER HAS FURNISHED TO THE <u>ADMINISTRATION OR</u> TITLE32SERVICE AGENT PROOF OF IDENTITY, VEHICLE OWNERSHIP, AND INSURANCE.

1(3) ★ THE ADMINISTRATION OR ATITLE SERVICE AGENT MAY NOT2ISSUE MORE THAN ONE TEMPORARY IN-TRANSIT REGISTRATION FOR ANY EACH3VEHICLE SALES TRANSACTION.

4 (F) THE ADMINISTRATION SHALL ADOPT REGULATIONS TO CARRY OUT 5 THIS SECTION.

6 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 7 October 1, 2019 June July 1, 2020.
