4 FOR the purpose of establishing the Baltimore City Anti–Violence Program Grant Fund as 5 a special, nonlapsing fund; specifying the purpose and contents of the Fund; 6 requiring a certain entity to administer the Fund; requiring the State Treasurer to 7 hold the Fund and the Comptroller, in conjunction with a certain entity, to account 8 for the Fund; providing for the investment of money in and expenditures from the 9 Fund; providing that the accounts and transactions of the Fund shall be subject to a certain audit; establishing that the Fund is not subject to a certain provision of law 10 11 requiring interest on State money in special funds to accrue to the General Fund of 12 the State; defining certain terms; and generally relating to the establishment of the Baltimore City Anti-Violence Program Grant Fund. 13

- 23 (G) (1) THE STATE TREASURER SHALL INVEST THE MONEY OF THE FUND
- 24 IN THE SAME MANNER AS OTHER STATE MONEY MAY BE INVESTED.
- 25 (2) ANY INTEREST EARNINGS OF THE FUND SHALL BE CREDITED TO

- 27 (H) EXPENDITURES FROM THE FUND MAY BE MADE ONLY IN ACCORDANCE
