## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

Criminal Law – Firearms – Computer–Aided Fabrication and Serial Number
 (3–D Printed Firearms and Ghost Guns)

- 4 FOR the purpose of prohibiting a person from transporting into the State a certain firearm that is not imprinted with a certain serial number or manufacturing, possessing, 5 6 selling, offering to sell, transferring, purchasing, or receiving a certain firearm that 7 is not imprinted with a certain serial number; prohibiting a person from using a 8 certain computer-aided fabrication device to manufacture a certain firearm; 9 prohibiting a person from possessing, selling, offering to sell, transferring, 10 purchasing, or receiving a certain firearm manufactured using a certain computer-aided fabrication device; establishing certain exceptions to certain 11 prohibitions established under this Act; establishing certain penalties; defining 12 13 certain terms; and generally relating to firearms.

- 10 (10) "Computer software" means a computer program, instruction, 11 procedure, or associated document regarding the operation of a computer system.
- 12 (11) "Computer system" means one or more connected or unconnected computers, peripheral devices, computer software, data, or computer programs.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2019.
