#### A BILL ENTITLED

# Public Health – Products Containing a Flame–Retardant Chemical – Prohibition on Import or Sale

4 FOR the purpose of prohibiting a person from importing, selling, or offering for sale any  $\mathbf{5}$ juvenile product, mattress, upholstered furniture, or reupholstered furniture that 6 contains more than a certain amount of certain chemicals; repealing certain 7 provisions of law regarding the importing, sale, or offering for sale of any child care product containing certain chemicals; establishing certain civil penalties; 8 9 authorizing a court to enjoin a certain action; authorizing the Secretary of Health to suspend implementation of certain provisions of this Act under certain 10 11 circumstances; requiring the Maryland Department of Health to adopt certain 12regulations on or before a certain date; providing for the application of certain 13 provisions of this Act; making conforming changes; defining certain terms; and 14 generally relating to products containing flame-retardant chemicals.
